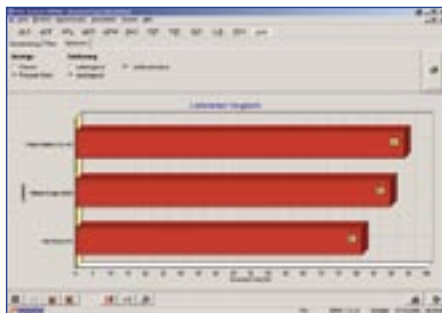
# Supplier Evaluation with HYDRA-LFB

The functions of HYDRA support you in evaluating your suppliers and in securing the long-term and strategic objectives of your company. For this purpose, quality criteria with different emphasis are used. If you evaluate your suppliers not only before awarding contracts but regularly you will find out the real benefit of a supplier evaluation. All incoming goods are always checked with respect to schedule deviations and quantity variances as well as concerning their quality characteristics. This is especially important for permanent suppliers.

Furthermore, the HYDRA-module supplier evaluation is compliant to the international quality standards of the VDA and the DGQ.



## Extensive functions support the CIP

### Basics of the assessment

- Individual definition of evaluation systems
- Freely definable evaluation criteria such as on-time delivery and delivery reliability, compliance with agreed quantities, quality of incoming goods, etc.
- Possibility to group and variably assess the evaluation criteria
- Determination of limit values for a classification into freely definable supplier classes
- Individual layout of assessment catalogs for an objective evaluation of different supplier groups

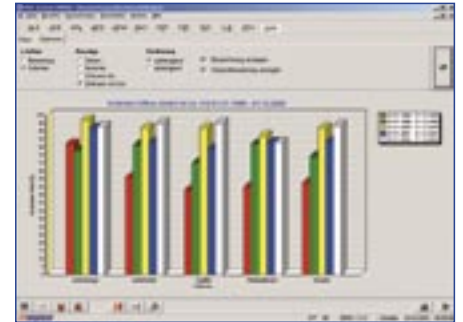
### Evaluations and analyses

- Qualitative evaluation of incoming goods according to VDA with the option between three rating procedures

- Triggering of escalations if previously defined limits are violated or certain events occur

- Secured identification of weak points of suppliers and targeted improvement of the delivery quality



- Permanent supplier evaluation for the continuous improvement of the suppliers efficiency
- Support of purchasing negotiations and supplier developments on the basis of objective key figures
- Recognition of coherences between delivery and product quality by comparing data which have been recorded and evaluated in other modules of HYDRA-CAQ such as the goods receipt or the initial sample inspection or the in-production inspection
